Heather Mitts, a three-time Olympic soccer champion who most recently won gold at the London 2012 Olympic Games, is now committed to giving back through the United States Olympic Committee's Team for Tomorrow program. As part of Team for Tomorrow, Mitts will visit the Christian Street YMCA on Tuesday, Dec. 18.

Beginning at 5 p.m., Mitts will share her personal story with young people and also speak about the importance of living an active and healthy lifestyle. Following her presentation, Mitts will lead the participants in various physical activities.

This event, which is open to the media, will take place at the Christian Street YMCA located at 1724 Christian St. in Philadelphia, Pa. Mitts will be available for interviews at the conclusion of the program.

The USOC launched Team for Tomorrow in 2008 in partnership with U.S. Olympians and Paralympians to provide a vehicle through which U.S. athletes can offer their assistance and support to those in need around the world, as well as a means to continue spreading the Olympic Values of excellence, friendship and respect.
