Members of the NFAA may participate in the 2012 USA Archery Events without having to join USA Archery; however, a USAA Membership is needed at the time of the event to gain a ranking for the 2013 Cadet USAT.

Top (5) boys and top (5) girls
Top (5) boys and top (5) girls

The 2013 Cadet USAT will be determined by Cadet Ranking System placement at 3 events:

1. 31ST Easton JOAD National Championships

- * Ties in the final Cadet USAT ranking will be broken by the athlete's placement in the elimination round, and if still tied, the athlete's ranking round placement.
