## 1. 2011 Para World Target Trials

Program:

Day One Official Practice

Day Two FITA Qualification Round - Long Distances

Day Three FITA Qualification Round - Short Distances

Top 8 Archers move on to the Round Robin Matches

**Day Four** Para World Target Championships - Round Robin Match Play

Top 8 Archers per class from FITA Qualification Round

#### 1.1 Qualification Round

1.1.1 For the Selection Event a FITA Round will be shot and points will be allocated to the Top 8 places, according to Table 1:

- 1.1.2 Archers in each class will shoot the following distances.
  - 1.1.2.1 Men W2, Standing, Open Compound 90, 70, 50, & 30 meters
  - 1.1.2.2 Men W1 and all Women Classes 70, 60, 50, & 30 meters
- 1.1.3 The FITA Round will have the effect of reducing the number of archers to the top 8 in each category.

## 2011 Para World Target Trials Procedures

- 1.1.4 A tie in points following the FITA Round will be broken in accordance with FITA Rules 7.6.5.1.
- 1.1.5 The top 8 archers will proceed to the Round Robin Match Play Competition on Day 4.

## 1.2 Ranking Round Bonus Points

1.2.1 Men and women archers will be awarded Ranking Round Bonus Points for Ranking Round Scores from Table 2, based on the 2011 National Team Scores.

#### 1.3 Round Robin Matches

- 1.3.1 In each of the classes with 8 archers, each archer will shoot against each other archer once.
- 1.3.2 In classes with less than 8 archers, compound and recurve archers will shoot in the appropriate divisions against each other for a total of 7 matches.
- 1.3.3 Each match will be conducted using Match Play Format, two ends of six arrows per end.
  - 1.3.3.1 Timing for six arrow ends will be 240 seconds per end.
- 1.3.4 Scores from the two ends will be added and bonus points given for an archer's cumulative score.
  - 1.3.4.1 Bonus points will be allocated according to Table 3:

## 1.4 Six Arrow Average Score

- 1.4.1 Following the series of seven matches in the Round Robin Competition, archers will be ranked according to their Six Arrow Average Score
- 1.4.2 Six Arrow Scores will be recorded for each match shot against other archers in Round Robin Match Play.
  - 1.4.2.1 The Six Arrow Average Score will be rounded to the thousandth place.
- 1.4.3 Scores shot during bye matches will not be calculated in the Six Arrow Average Score.
- 1.4.4 Bonus Points will be allocated according to the archer's Six Arrow Average Score Ranking, as shown in Table 4:

- 1.1.1 In the event of a tie in the Six Arrow Average Score, a single arrow shoot-off will be shot to break the tie.
  - 1.1.1.1 Timing for shoot-offs will be 40 seconds per arrow as per FITA Rules 7.5.5.2

## 2. Team Selection for the 2011 Para World Target Championships

## 2.1 Team Selection Points Available

2.1.1 Top 8 archers will be ranked by adding the total accumulated Ranking and Bonus Points during all phases of the selection shoot.

- 2.1.2 In the event of a tie in the Final Total Points per class there will be a 12-arrow match to break a tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Place.
  - 2.1.2.1 In the event of a tie in the 12-arrow match, a single arrow shoot-off will determine the winner.
    - 2.1.2.1.1 Timing for shoot-offs will be 40 seconds per arrow as per FITA Rules 7.5.5.2

#### 2011 Para World Target Trials Procedures

- 2.1.3 The top three archers in each of the competed classes will be nominated to the 2011 Para World Target Championships Team.
- 2.1.4 All archers nominated to USA Archery 2011 Para World Target Championships Team must stay for a meeting with the Team Leader immediately after the Selection Event has concluded.
- 2.1.5 In the event that a top three (3) ranked archer is unable to compete for the US Team, USA Archery will select the next available archer based on the final ranking order in that category from the trials.

## 3. Additional Rules Regarding 2011 Para World Team Trials

- 3.1 FITA Rules apply to all components of the 2011 Para World Team Trials.
- 3.2 There will be no equipment failures during Round Robin Matches.
- 3.3 Round Robin Matches will be shot using Match Play Competition.
- 3.4 Archery as responsible for ensuring their scores are correct. If a scoring mistake is discovered after bonus points are awarded, the score may not be considered in accordance with established USA Archery Scoring Procedures.
- 3.5 If an archer placing within the top 8 from the FITA Round is unable to continue, the next archer in the ranking place (9th, 10th, etc.) shall be included in the remaining portions of the event. This must take place prior to the start of the Round Robin Matches.
- 3.6 Upon commencement of the Round Robin Matches, the Ranking Round Score and Bonus Points are considered final.
- 3.7 If an archer, for any reason, is unable to participate or continue in the Selection Event, the archer concerned shall be deemed to have abandoned the event.
- 3.8 USA Archery Event Protocol will be followed throughout the course of the Selection Event.
