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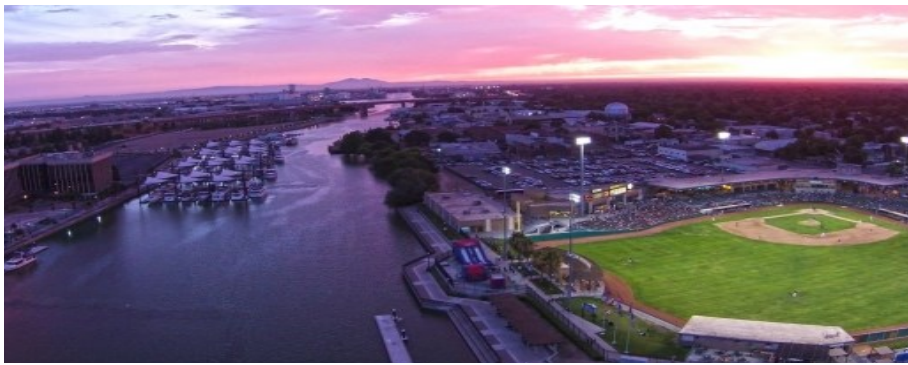

Rules and Eyewear

USA Racquetball Official Rules will govern competition, including the mandatory use of protective eyewear tested to impact standards. It is the player's responsibility to ensure that their eyewear conforms with the standard in Rule 2.5 (a).

Officiating / Rules Test

Match losers are expected to referee a match immediately following a loss. Both players from a losing doubles team should report to the Championship Desk to see if both may be needed to referee. All Players are required to take the online A3 Junior Referee Test prior to the event. The test is FREE! Eligibility:

Players must meet the age requirement as of January 1, 2017. Only U.S. citizens and residents are eligible to participate.

If you sign up for Challenger Divisions you may not sign up for Championship divisions and visa versa EXCEPT Mixed Doubles. If you have played in previous Junior Olympic double-bounce, you may not enter double-bounce divisions.

Format: Championship Singles will be Olympic

Format with 4 flights in each age group, Gold, Blue, Red & White, thus ensuring that a player typically has a minimum of 3 matches per division and eventually plays against similarly skilled players during the event.
