I. BACKGROUND

1. This matter was commenced on February 27, 2015, when Lynn Pearce Wooldridge-Thursby (“Wooldridge-Thursby”) filed a Section 10 Complaint against USA Judo (“USAJ”).

2. The Hearing Panel held a Preliminary Hearing conference call with the Parties on April 29, 2015.

3. In its Order of May 11, 2015, the Hearing Panel set forth the following discovery schedule:

- a) USAJ shall file its Request for Production, if any, by May 29, 2015.
- b) If there are discovery issues, the Parties shall meet and confer by June 12, 2015, in an attempt to resolve them.
- c) If there are any outstanding discovery issues after the Parties meet and confer, the Parties shall notify the Hearing Panel by June 19, 2015, with accompanying reasons why production is objected to or should be compelled.

4. Wooldridge-Thursby had filed a Request for an Order Directing Production of Documents and Other Information on April 27, 2015.

5. The Parties have informed the Hearing Panel that they have complied with the above schedule. Production of non-contested materials is scheduled to occur on July 1, 2015.

6. However, outstanding issues remain regarding the production of certain materials requested of USAJ by Wooldridge-Thursby.

7. On June 19, 2015, Wooldridge-Thursby filed a Motion to Compel Further Production of Documents and Other Information (“Motion to Compel”).

II. DISCOVERY ORDER

8. USAJ shall file a response to Wooldridge-Thursby’s Motion to Compel by July 8, 2015.

9. The Hearing Panel will hold a hearing on the Motion to Compel the week of July 13, 2015. Such hearing shall be scheduled after determining available dates for the Hearing Panel members and the Parties.

10. At the hearing the Parties should be prepared to discuss when materials subject to the Motion to Compel can and should be produced. Thus, if the Hearing Panel determines to grant in whole or in part the Motion to Compel, the Hearing Panel can set a date for such production after having input from the Parties.

11. The Parties shall produce non-contested materials as schedule on July 1, 2015.

III. ORDER

12. It is so ordered.
