



4. The Parties provided an update concerning their mediation efforts as requested on August 31, 2018.
5. On October 1, 2018, the Parties requested that this matter be stayed until November 1, 2018, to allow additional time to continue their mediation efforts.
6. On October 19, 2018, the Hearing Panel granted the extension to stay the proceeding until November 1, 2018, providing the Parties with additional time in which to attempt to resolve this matter through mediation.
7. On November 1, 2018, Sanderson withdrew his Complaint.
8. The Hearing Panel did not receive the required update as to the status of mediation efforts from the remaining Parties<sup>2</sup>.
9. On November 9, 2018, the Hearing Panel reached out to the remaining Parties and requested status of the mediation efforts.
10. USAS updated the Hearing Panel on November 12, 2018, that no resolution was reached but the Parties were still in communication. USAS also notified the Hearing Panel that Tagliapietra requested an additional three weeks to resolve the matter. However, USAS indicated that unless the Parties made progress on the mediation efforts that day, USAS was prepared to proceed with the Complaint.
11. The Parties updated the Hearing Panel on November 15, 2018, that they were still attempting to resolve the pending matter. The Hearing Panel notified the Parties that if the negotiations were not completed by November 26, 2018, the Section 10 would proceed.

12. On November 28, 2018, the Parties requested another extension until November 30, 2018. The Hearing Panel once again granted the request but communicated that it was a hard deadline and no further extensions would be granted.

13. On December 3, 2018, the Parties communicated to the Hearing Panel that an agreement between the Parties to resolve the matter was expected “shortly.” The Hearing Panel requested to hear back from the parties by the end of the day.


14. On December 6, 2018, the Hearing Panel had not heard back from the parties which resulted in the Hearing Panel notifying the Parties that the Section 10 proceeding would move forward.<sup>3</sup>

15. On December 8, 2018, Tagliapietra withdrew his Complaint.

16. As both Complainants withdrew their Complaint, this matter is concluded and the case is now closed.
