ORDER

March 29, 2013

I. THE PARTIES

1. Allison Baver, Nate Di Palma, Jack Jayner, Levi Kirkpatrick, Jordan Malone, Eva Rodansky, James Rodowsky and Patricia Rodowsky (“Complainants”) are members of U.S. Speedskating (“USS”). Complainants also are athletes competing in the sport of speedskating.

2. USS is the National Governing Body (“NGB”) for the sport of speedskating in the United States, as recognized by the United States Olympic Committee (“USOC”) pursuant to the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act (36 USC §§ 220501-220529) (the “Act”) and Section 8 of the USOC Bylaws.

II. COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDING

3. On March 5, 2013, Complainants filed a Complaint against USS pursuant to Section 220527 of the Act and Section 10 of the USOC Bylaws.

III. PANEL COMPOSITION

4. In accordance with Section 220527(a)(2) of the Act and Section 10.6 of the USOC Bylaws, USOC Chief Executive Officer, Scott Blackmun, appointed a Hearing Panel of three members for the purpose of hearing this matter. The Panel members are:
