I, THE UNDERSIGNED ARBITRATOR, having been designated in accordance with Article IX, Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States Olympic Committee ("USOC") and under the Amateur Sports Act of 1978, 36 U.S.C. §371, et seq. and after hearing the testimony and studying the evidence presented, it is the judgment of the Arbitrator that Complainants David Montalvo, Jean Lopez, and George Weissfisch did not establish by a preponderance of the evidence that the United States Taekwondo Union denied or threatened to deny them the opportunity to compete in the 1997 World Championship competition. Accordingly the relief sought by the complaining parties is denied.

The fees and expenses of the American Arbitration Association totaling \$1,000.00 and the fees and expenses of the Arbitrator totaling \$2,850.00 shall be borne 75% by the United States Taekwando Union and 25% by the Complainants. Said fees and expenses are to be paid as directed by the Association.

This Award is in full settlement of all claims submitted to this arbitration.
