ORDER ENJOINING KEITH SIERACKI

This matter came before the Court on the emergency motion of Lindland to enjoin Keith Sieracki,
 and the Court being advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- (1) Lindland's motion to enjoin Keith Sieracki is GRANTED;
- (2) Keith Sieracki and anyone in privity or active concert with him is immediately enjoined;

(a) to immediately dismiss the arbitral proceedings that he has initiated in the Court of Arbitration for Sport;

(b) to take all other steps necessary to effectuate an immediate termination of that arbitration without a ruling on the merits; and

(c) to otherwise refrain from and cease initiating or participating in any and all proceedings to undermine or frustrate the judgment of this Court in these consolidated appeals (with the exception of those procedures for rehearing or petition for certiorari that are permitted under the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure or Rules of the United States Supreme Court);

(3) failure by any person or entity subject to this Order to immediately and unconditionally comply with this Order will result in a hearing at which this Court will be prepared to hold the violators in contempt and to award sanctions; and

(4) this Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this order and the injunctive order issued by Judge Zagel on August 29, 2000, including in order to conduct such contempt proceedings as may be necessary.
