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Divemeets

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Sportsmanship Statement

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship by athlete members, coach members and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athlete members, coach members, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Anti-bullying Policy

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying and acts of cyberbullying by members, towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of Audiovisual Equipment

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

Deck Changing

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Clean Deck Policy

USA Diving observes a clean deck policy at all meets. USA Diving's clean deck policy states only credentialed members (coaches & athletes registered for the meet, officials, medical personnel, support staff, and approved meet operations volunteers) may be present on the pool deck during a sanctioned event.

Hot Tub

The hot tub will be available for warm up-and-go use throughout the competition, as well as the hot showers under the platform. Lingering and congregating in these areas is against Covid protocol.

Entering the Meet

All athlete members and coach member meet entries must be made online at www.divemeets.com.

Entry Fees:

\$65 registration fee and \$50 insurance surcharge per event

Late Registration

Coach Members – If a coach member misses the online registration deadline, a \$20 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

Athlete Members – Athlete members may still register after the deadline. A \$100 late fee will be assessed in addition to the entry fee if registering online after the deadline. If registering on deck, a \$100 late fee will be assessed, and the entry fee will be \$75 per event. Athlete members previously registered for the meet who wish to add an event will only pay \$75 per event.

NOTE: All divers and coach must be current with Safe Sport prior to receiving deck authorization.

Teams with four or more athlete members:

May receive 1 coach credential and 2 support credentials

Support credentials are for assistant coaches, graduate assistants, videographers, and/or trainers. **All must be age 18+ and hold a current USA Diving membership** (coach or volunteer/official category).

Number of athletes is determined by the Coach of Record report so please be sure to have all your athlete members accurately reflecting their coach of record when registering.

Only credentialed members are allowed on deck. All credentialed members **MUST** be current USA Diving members and current Safe Sport certified.

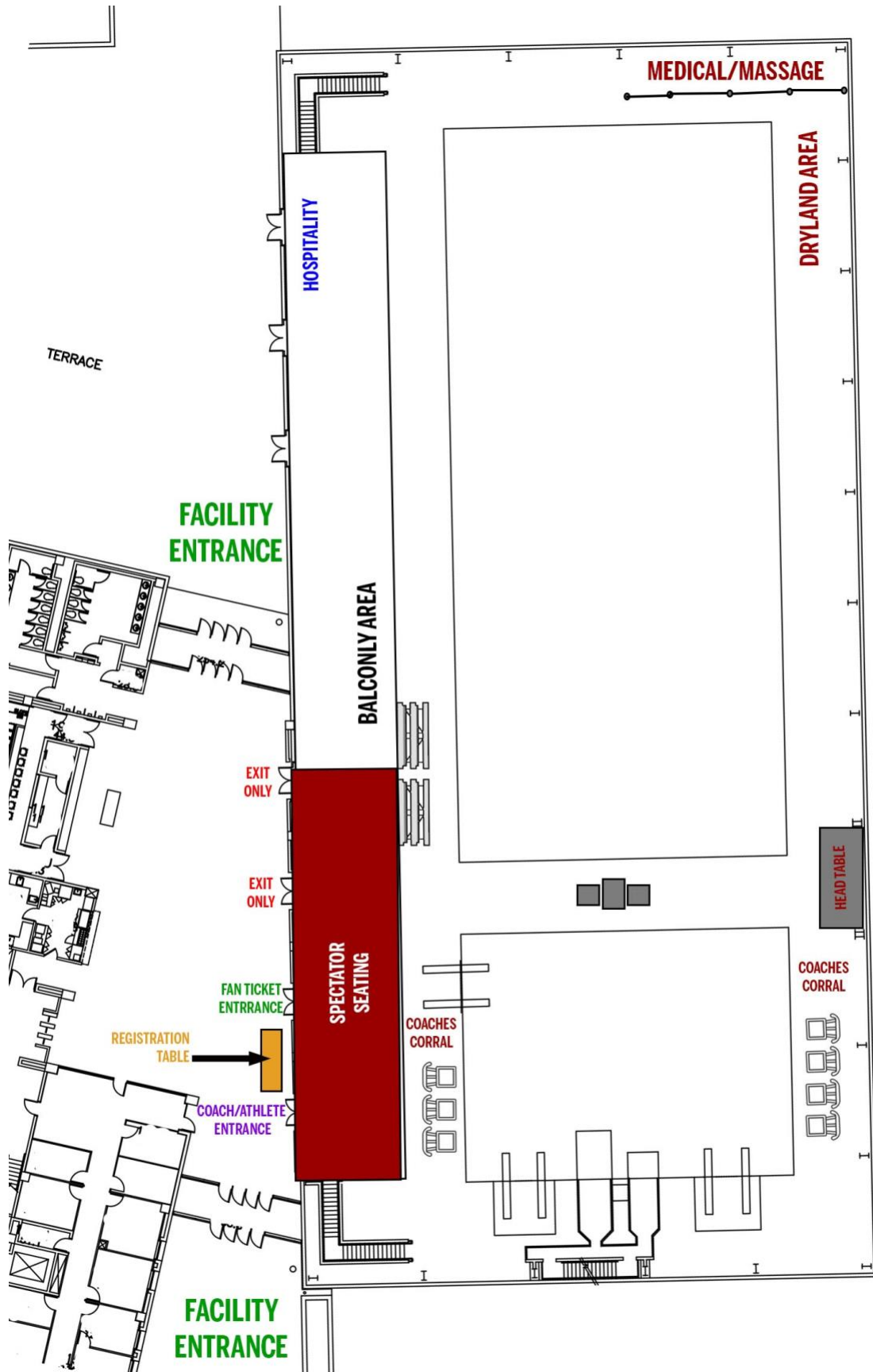

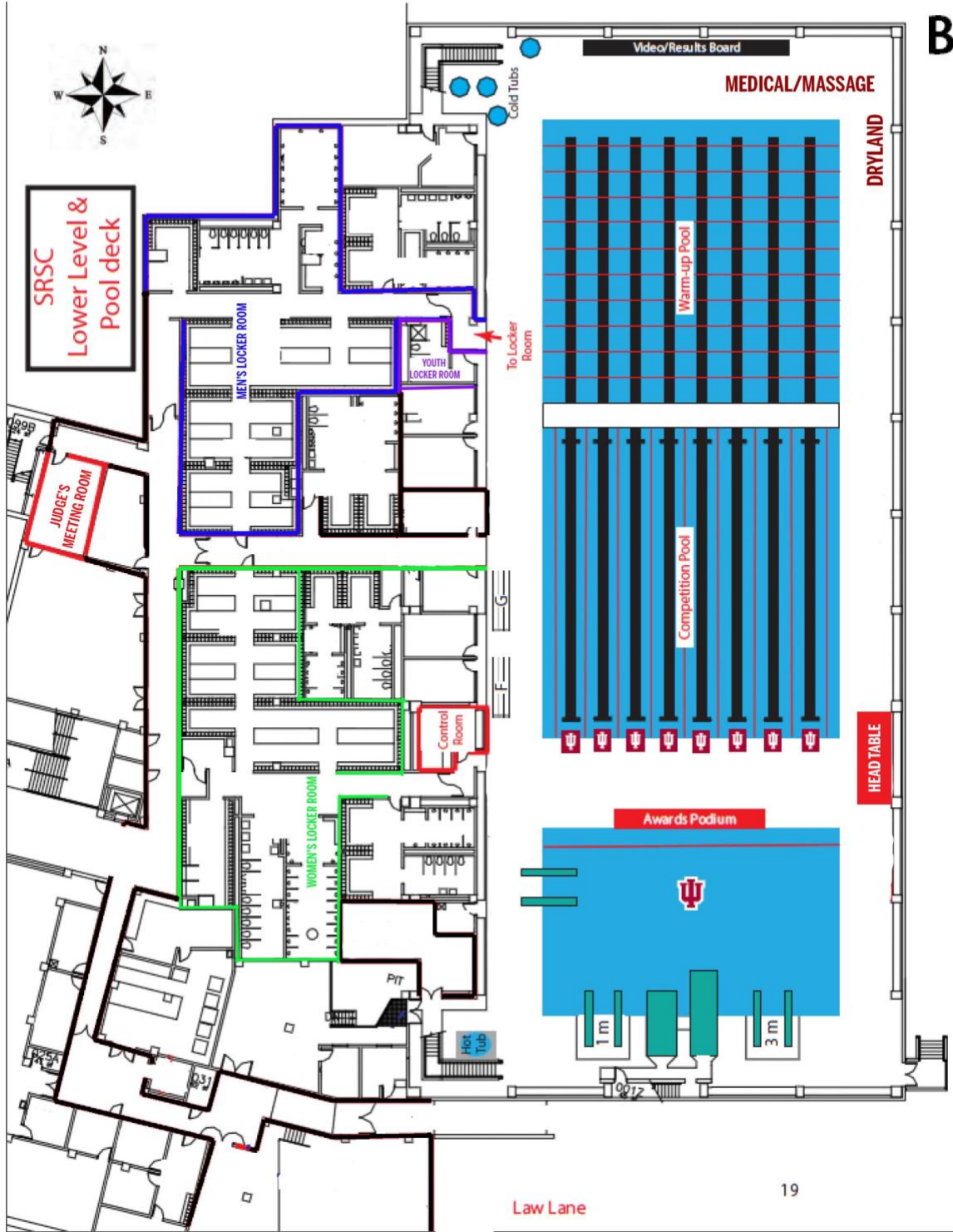
