**What is the U.S. National Indoor Championships?** The U.S. National Indoor Championships is a separate event offered in conjunction with the JOAD National Indoor Championships over the course of four weekends at multiple regional indoor locations across the United States.

**Membership Required:** Participants in the U.S. National Indoor must be current members of USA Archery. Be prepared to show proof of membership at the event. If no membership can be shown, be prepared to purchase a USA Archery membership upon arrival.

**NFAA Membership Tournament Reciprocity:** National Field Archery Association (NFAA) membership WILL BE recognized for participation purposes only, at all USA Archery sanctioned competitions, so long as the individual has obtained a USA Archery Temporary Membership for that event, *for which the \$15 temporary membership fee will be waived for NFAA members.* The only exception to this tournament reciprocity will be selection to international teams, and any tournament that requires JOAD club membership, i.e. JOAD National Indoor Championships and Easton JOAD Nationals. **Citizenship:** Competitors must be U.S. citizens to be eligible to compete for National titles. Non-citizens will shoot in the Guest Division.

**What categories are offered?** Check the registration document for the specific site where you wish to compete at.

**What rounds are offered?**

**Recurve Bow** - Two rounds of 60 arrows each (120 total) at a 40 cm target face from 18 meters with outer ten-ring scoring.

**Compound Bow** - Two rounds of 60 arrows each (120 total) at a 40 cm target face from 18 meters with inner ten-ring scoring. (Including Compound, Compound Fingers [for masters only], and Crossbow)

**Are there separate categories (age/gender)?** Yes, men and women shoot in different divisions as well as recurve and compound.

**Are there equipment or dress code rules?** Yes, equipment and dress code must

comply with USAA and World Archery rules including footwear. Complete information: <http://www.teamusa.org/USA-Archery/Resources/Rules-and-Policies>

**Is there registration on site at the event?** No, all archers must register and pay in advance to reserve a shooting spot. Space is limited to the capacity of each venue. Register early!

**Which Location is Best for Me?** Participants may compete at any of the locations for this event noted on the USA Archery website. Residents of each region will have registration priority should any one location reach full capacity.
