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JDT Determination & Commitment

It takes a tremendous amount of commitment to remain competitive on the National and International level. As a member of the JDT-C, you must be totally committed to excellence and continuing to learn, grow and improve. You do this not only as an individual JDT-C member and competitor, but as a team as well. It must be that you are determined to be the best in the world, not just the best in the United States. The following is the minimum commitment that a potential JDT-C Archer must display:

- Attend at least 2 of the JOAD, Jr. USAT, outdoor ranking tournaments.
- Attend at least 1 NFAA or USAT National Indoor tournaments
- Attend Cadet / Jr. World trials if you are competing in a class that is participating in the Cadet / Jr. World Championships.
- Attend 1 JDT camps per calendar year.

- Show continuing technical progress in your shooting form.
- Show continuing improvement in the ability to self-coach.
- Show physical progress from camp to camp using the Beep Test or the fitness test results.
- Be able to demonstrate and explain the National Training System Compound before a group.
- Be a team player.
- Participate in all JDT camp activities unless injured.
- Display exemplary sportsmanship and respect to others at all times.
- Maintain contact with assigned JDT coach between camps by email, phone, Skype or video.
- Submit JDT Home Log Book daily to assigned JDT Coach.
- Always follow JDT Code of Conduct.
