A National Paralympic Coach of the Year nominee is a coach of an Elite Level Club, Collegiate, Para Pan-Am, World Championship or Paralympic Games coach or the coach of an elite athlete who competes at the highest level of your sport. This award is based on the accomplishments of the coach for the year 2016. The nominee must currently be coaching or within their first year of retirement.

Applicants will be scored based solely on the information that is provided so be as thorough as possible. If you need additional space to fully explain why this coach should be the 2016 National Paralympic Coach of the Year, please attach it with your application.
