

World Cup stop #4: **Lake Placid, N.Y.** - is a village in the Adirondack Mountains in Essex County, New York, United States, near the center of the Town of North Elba, 52 miles (84 km) southwest of Plattsburgh. Lake Placid, along with nearby Saranac Lake and Tupper Lake, comprise what is known as the Tri-Lakes region. As of the 2010 census, the village had a population of 2,521.
