



International Club Exchanges Policies and Procedures

1. FOR ALL EXCHANGES
 - A. ALL participants of club exchanges must be registered and in good standing with their respective National Federation and must adhere to the rules of USA Boxing, Inc.
 - B. International Club Exchange teams may not represent themselves as “Team USA” on their competition suits or in advertising the event.
 - C. Teams, whether USA Boxing, club or foreign, must be designated as club teams and may not be referred to as national teams.

2. COMPETITION TAKING PLACE **WITHIN** THE UNITED STATES
 - A. Requirements
 - 1) The U.S. Club needs to send a letter of invitation to the foreign club, to include financial provisions for travel, lodging, meals, etc. (*example attached*)
 - 2) Letter of approval from foreign club’s national governing body stating the team may travel to and participate in the competition
 - 3) Completed USA Boxing International Club Exchange application, to include boxers, coaches, officials, chaperones and guests; dates of departure and return
 - 4) Certificate of insurance coverage for the foreign delegation stipulating coverage for travel and competition in the United States (*example attached*) **OR** payment of Travored insurance, \$5.00 per person per day
 - a. Travored insurance may be obtained by contacting the Membership Dept. in the National Office (719-866-2323)
 - 5) Submit International Club Exchange Results form to USA Boxing within 10 days after the close of the competition

3. COMPETITION WITH A **BORDERING COUNTRY** (CANADA AND MEXICO) *Policy covers competition in the United States, Canada and Mexico*
 - A. Requirements
 - 1) Sanction holder shall submit a completed International Club Exchange application to USA Boxing after applying for the sanction through Webpoint or accepting an invitation to box in Canada or Mexico
 - 2) Submit International Club Exchange Results form to USA Boxing within 10 days after the close of the competition
 - 3) Please note, travel insurance is *not* required for border exchanges

4. COMPETITION TAKING PLACE **OUTSIDE** THE UNITED STATES
 - A. Requirements
 - 1) Letter of invitation from the foreign club, to include financial provisions for travel, lodging, meals, etc.
 - 2) Completed USA Boxing International Club Exchange application, to include boxers, coaches, officials, chaperones and guests; dates of departure and return
 - 3) Payment of Travored insurance, \$5.00 per person per day
 - a. Travored insurance may be obtained by contacting the Membership Dept. in the National Office (719-866-2323)
 - 4) Submit International Club Exchange Results form to USA Boxing within 10 days after the close of the competition
