



Pro-Am Boxing Events Policies and Procedures

- 1) As with all USA Boxing shows, Pro-Am sanctions will only be granted to current USA Boxing member clubs.
- 2) The host club or LBC would submit the sanction online, choosing Pro-Am Event when asked for the type of sanction.
- 3) The USA Boxing National Office must approve the Pro-Am show; it cannot be approved at the LBC level. **Before the Pro-Am will be approved, the USA Boxing National Office must:**
 - Have the approval of the Local Boxing Committee. If the LBC is unable to accommodate the event, the sanction will be denied or rescheduled.
 - Receive a Certificate of 3rd party liability insurance for the pro portion of the event.
 - Receive proof of accident insurance for each pro boxer.
- 4) The 3rd party liability insurance and proof of accident insurance for the professional boxers must be faxed (719-866-2132) or emailed to membership@usaboxing.org as soon as possible, but no less than five (5) working days BEFORE the event
- 5) USA Boxing and the LBC will only be responsible for the amateur portion of the event. Pro-Am events shall be governed by current USA Boxing rules, policies and procedures.
- 6) The LBC shall collect \$100 per amateur bout contested at the show. The pro promoter is responsible for paying this fee directly to the LBC on the day of the show.
- 7) The LBC president or his/her designee must complete and send to the USA Boxing National Office the Financial Statement for Competition within 14 days following the event.
