**Staff on the call:** Mike McAtee, Mike Campbell, Ethan Figge, Lynette Smith, Stacy Arredondo, and Kassie Manguilli.

**Welcome from Mike McAtee, Executive Director:** Thank you for the great work that you do. McAtee introduced Kassie Manguilli, our new Events Coordinator.

- **Ukrainian Crisis:** The international boxing community is helping. USA Boxing is following the guidance of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and United States Olympic Paralympic Committee (USOPC).
- **Olympics:** For Paris 2023, we are in the Olympics program with 7 men's and 6 women's weight classes, but we are not in the program for LA 2028. Good news is the host city as well as the USOPC are supporting us to be included, but IBA has to follow protocol before decision is made.
- **Qualifiers:** Elite boxers going to Cleveland: guidelines going out before March 14.
- **Sanctions without Doctors:** We had 900 sanctions in 2021 but over 350 without doctors. We

learned that LBCs are having events without doctors who are members in good standing. *THIS IS CRITICAL, PLEASE CHECK YOUR RINGSIDE PHYSICIANS' STATUS IN WEBPOINT.*

- If a doctor works an event and is not a current member, they are not covered by insurance.
- A doctor is needed for each ring.
- **Ethan Figge** reported that if a doctor is not listed two weeks out, a notice will go out to remind sanction holders. If not by one week, sanctions will be taken off the calendar. If still not in by the Wednesday prior to the event, it will be cancelled. If you have a doctor lined up and it's just not in system yet, reach out to Ethan.

#### **Events & Boxing Operations Update - Mike Campbell, Boxing Operations & Events Manager:**

- Reported that the Cleveland national event registration began and there are already 150 boxers; 30 officials; and 115 coaches registered. ***Space is limited.***
  - No check-in on Sunday just Friday and Saturday.
  - OIC (officials in charge) training will be on Sunday along with a technical seminar and the draw. Weigh-ins and boxing begin on Monday. There will be an Alumni event on Sunday.
  - There will be 4 rings and no more than 1000 boxers. There are quotas for each weight class. When filled, there will be a wait-list.
  - Contact Taryn Cass if someone that is not in the hotel block for Cleveland needs to be. Cost-share officials: \$550 for single room and any nights prior to the 23<sup>rd</sup> will \$135 per night unless notified otherwise. (To request single room fill out the survey that was sent out)
- Surveys

- Virtual Officials in charge (OIC) trainings were conducted. At some point, we will require a OIC at every event. We plan to have more OIC trainings, which include critical incident training for medical, criminal, and weather emergencies.
- Coaches Education: we are getting more clinicians for Train the Trainer, and having trainings at regional events.
