

USA BOXING
ADDITIONAL OFFICIALS SELECTION PROCEDURES
2015 Pan American Games
February 5, 2015

These procedures provide for selection of USA Boxing’s Additional Official position(s) for the 2015 Pan American Games. However, accreditation allocation is not guaranteed and the number of Additional Officials will be based on final USOC credential allocation and overall team size.

1. Describe the specific Additional Official position(s) that the NGB is requesting.

Title	Responsibility
Medical Provider	Assist with team’s medical needs

2. Describe the NGB’s criteria for the above-mentioned Additional Official position(s).

- 2.1. Medical Provider must:

- 2.1.1. Successfully pass the National Center for Safety Initiatives’ (NCSI) background screen in accordance with the current USOC Games Background Check Policy prior to nomination.

- 2.1.1.1. Should a nominee experience any event between the time the background check is conducted and the relevant Games that may change his/her background check status, the nominee must inform the NGB and/or USOC.

- 2.1.2. Possess a valid passport that does not expire until at least six months after the conclusion of the Games.

- 2.1.3. Be in good health and able to withstand the physical rigors of traveling with and working with the Team.

- 2.1.4. Possess the appropriate certifications.

- 2.1.5. Pass a medical credential review in addition to the approved USOC Games Background Check.

- 2.1.6. Be approved for nomination through USOC’s Sports Medicine Division.

- 2.1.7. Be the current USA Boxing Athletic Trainer or other qualified individual.

3. Describe the process that candidates should follow to express interest in being considered for Additional Official position(s):

USA Boxing will not solicit applications for the Medical Provider position.

4. Describe the intended method of identifying the pool and selecting the candidates to be considered for Additional Official position(s):

If there is a USA Boxing Athletic Trainer currently on staff, then USA Boxing’s Executive Director will make the final approval for this individual to fill the position.

If there is not a USA Boxing Athletic Trainer on staff, then USA Boxing's Executive Director and Director of High Performance, as well as an athlete representative will identify the individual who best meets the criteria in #2 above from USA Boxing's limited pool of medical providers who have served in this capacity at international competition(s), USA Boxing sanctioned camp(s), and/or domestic competition(s), providing medical services to U.S. boxers during the past quadrennial.

5. Describe the removal of an Additional Official:

An individual who is to be nominated as an Additional Official by USA Boxing may be removed as a nominee for any of the following reasons, as determined by USA Boxing:

- 5.1. Voluntary withdrawal. Nominee must submit a written letter to the NGB Executive Director/CEO/President.
- 5.2. Injury or illness as certified by a physician (or medical staff) approved by the NGB. If the individual refuses verification of his/her illness or injury by a physician (or medical staff) approved by the NGB, his/her injury will be assumed to be disabling and he/she may be removed.
- 5.3. Inability to perform the duties required.
- 5.4. Violation of USA Boxing's Code of Conduct (<http://www.teamusa.org/USA-Boxing/Rulebook/Forms-and-Documents>).

Once an Additional Official nomination is accepted by the USOC, the USOC has jurisdiction over the Additional Official, at which time, in addition to any applicable NGB Code of Conduct, the USOC's Code of Conduct and Grievance Procedures apply. 6. Describe the replacement of an Additional Official:

In the event that the Nominated Additional Official is unable to perform his/her duties due to injury, illness, Code of Conduct violation or any other unforeseen circumstances that would result in the need to replace him/her, the replacement candidate must meet all of the criteria listed in #2 above and, if applicable, come from the pool of candidates described in #4 above.

7. Which group/committee will make the final approval of the Additional Official(s)?

If there is a USA Boxing Athletic Trainer currently on staff, then USA Boxing's Executive Director will make the final approval for this individual to fill the position.

If there is not a USA Boxing Athletic Trainer on staff, then USA Boxing's Executive Director and Director of High Performance, as well as an athlete representative will determine the individual who best meets the criteria in #2 above from USA Boxing's limited pool of medical providers as described in #4 above.

8. Conflict of Interest:

Any individual who is being considered for an Additional Official position or has any other conflict of interest and is involved in the selection process must disclose this information, recuse him or herself and not influence others regarding the discussions, meetings or decisions involving selection of that Additional Official position.

9. Date of Nomination:

The Games Staff Nomination Form with Additional Official nominees' names, including names of any replacements (if applicable), will be submitted to the USOC on or before: May 22, 2015



10. Publicity/Distribution of Procedures:

* Signature by the Athlete Representative constitutes that he/she has read and understands the Selection Procedures. If the Athlete Representative reads and does not agree with the Selection Procedures being submitted by the NGB, he/she may submit those reasons in writing to his/her Sport Performance Team.

* If, for some reason, a sport does not have an elected USOC AAC Representative, the NGB must designate an athlete from that sport to review and sign the Selection Procedures.
