## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

\*The policies and procedures contained in this document are supplemental. All rules, policies and procedures as stated in the LBC Bylaws and the USA Boxing Rulebook must be followed. The information provided here is specific to this LBC and cannot contradict or violate aforementioned bylaws and rulebook. This information is provided for the members' convenience and may be updated from time to time.

### Sanctions

Sanction holder must contact the LBC President or LBC Secretary for date verification and approval **prior to** applying for a sanction through WebPoint, and before they create and distribute a flyer.

You may apply for your sanction a minimum of 30-45 days prior to the date of competition.

When you apply for your sanction, you must select the LBC Chief of Officials (COO) as the primary Official in Charge (OIC). If the LBC COO is unavailable to attend the event, the COO will choose an appropriate OIC.

In the event that a sanction is denied due to the lack of adequate officials (minimum of 7), but the host says, "I can secure them," then the list of officials should be submitted to the COO no less than 5 days prior to the event.

Per the USA Boxing rulebook, there will be no "exhibition bouts" allowed during any event. Developmental bouts are allowed if the boxers have two or fewer total bouts (experience). There is a maximum of two developmental bouts per event.

### Sanction provisions

If the LBC COO will be in attendance, the bout sheet must be submitted to the COO on the Wednesday **before** the competition date.

If the LBC COO **will not** be in attendance, the list of officials committed to working the event must be submitted to the COO no less than **5 days prior** to the competition date. Bout sheets must be submitted to the COO on the Wednesday **before** the competition date.

During an event, the LBC COO/OIC has the right to refuse any bout sheet additions, after the bout sheet has been printed and the event has begun.

No registrations, passbooks, or yearly physicals will be provided on any day of any event. These things need to be taken care of before you show up to box.
