Location: Veterans Memorial High School Gym at 3750 Cimarron Blvd, Corpus Christi, TX 78414

Eligibility: Open to members holding current USA JUDO, AJJF, USJI, USJF, USJA, and ATJA, cards. Proof of membership must be presented at registration.

Rules: Current IJF rules (modified). **LEG GRAB** – Article 25 – Hansoku-make (Item 12). The first violation shall be penalized with Shido and the second violation shall be penalized with Hansoku-make. This applies to all non-Senior Divisions. **JUDO GI** – Article 3 – Is modified to use the pre-2014 gi fit requirements to be applied within reason based upon the size of the player. No Hansoku-make will be given for the first violation and the player will be given the opportunity to change gi, even if the contest has started. This applies to all divisions.

The use of blue and white gis is encouraged. All competitors must have at least a white gi. A match between two blue gis will not be permitted. Female players are to wear a solid white shirt under their gi. Remember if you do not bring a blue and a white gi, you must provide your own white and blue belts. Novice cannot use chokes or armbars regardless of age.

Method of Competition: Double Elimination for divisions with six players or more. Round Robin will be used for divisions of five players or less.

Match Duration: All junior matches are 3 minutes. All novice and masters' matches are 3 minutes. All men's and women's matches are 4 minutes.

Awards: 3" custom state championship medals and neck ribbons for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category will be given.

Coaches: All coaches with a USA Judo Coaching Badge will be admitted at no charge. Coaching chairs will be provided.

Spectators/Parking: \$5 spectator fee

Kata Competition: Nage No Kata, Katame No Kata, Ju No Kata, Goshin Jitsu, and Itsusu No Kata divisions will be offered. To help us with preparations, all kata teams must pre-register by the **POSTMARK mail-in deadline of May 13, 2019**. Kata teams are \$55 per team for the first kata and \$45 per team for each additional kata.

Entry Fee: DO NOT MAIL WITH "SIGNATURE REQUIRED" DELIVERY. THIS ONLY DELAYS YOUR REGISTRATION. Competitors may pre-register at a discounted rate of \$55.00, with each additional division \$40.00. All entries must be **POSTMARKED by Monday, May 13** to receive the discounted rate. For those registering at the door, the entry fee is \$65.00, with each additional division entered \$45.00. Kata teams must pre-register and are \$55 per team for the first kata, and \$45 per team for each additional kata. **No refunds will be given for pre-registered athletes who are unable to attend the event. A Family Discount of \$5 per family member will be given to immediate family members living in the same household.**

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the Bay Area Judo Tournament and related events and activities of United States Judo, Inc. (USA JUDO), USJA, USJF, ATJA, AJJF, Lopez Judo Academy, Veterans Memorial High School, Corpus Christi Independent School District, Sembradores de Amistad of Corpus Christi, Tournament Director, Tournament Organizers, Tournament Staff, Local Organizing Committee, I hereby:

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury), and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages caused by, arising out of, resulting from or following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
5. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the USA Judo, United States Judo, Inc., the United States Olympic Committee, United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, ATJA, AJJF, Texas Judo, Lopez Judo Academy, Veterans Memorial High School, Corpus Christi Independent School District, Sembradores de Amistad of Corpus Christi, Tournament Director, Tournament Organizers, Tournament Staff, together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releasee", from any and all claims, demands, losses, actions, causes of actions or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability and death and damage to property
