

Official's Credential

This is a required card that the USLA provides to all our officials in good standing. This card indicates your status as a Luge Official (FIL, National, year of last rules update, "active", etc.) If you plan to work races this year, you are required to hold an Official's Credential. In order to receive this credential, you must have the following paperwork in to the main office in Lake Placid before the race season begins. Current Membership Dues, Signed Waiver & Release of Liability, Grant of Permission, Signed Code of Conduct, Signed Liability/Medical Release. You have already received the dues renewal form in the mail as well as the Waiver & Release of Liability & Grant of Permission (these are on the back of the membership form). You must also sign and return the enclosed **Code of Conduct** and the **Liability/Medical Release**. The Liability/Medical Release will be laminated to the back of your new credential. Upon receipt of "all" of your paperwork, you will be issued an Official's Credential within the week. Please note that the officials' credential you received last year is no longer valid.

LIABILITY/MEDICAL RELEASE
