## NATIONAL OFFICIAL'S COURSE

The national official's course is an entry level certification for officiating at our national races. This is the first step in becoming certified as a luge race official and required to become an FIL (International Luge Federation) Judge. For the national course you will learn the rules of the two competitions of Kunstbahn (artificial track - Olympic style) and Naturbahn (natural track). At the end of the course you will be given a written exam which will certify you as a US National Luge Official. You will receive an official's pin and certificate, and of course the opportunity to officiate at our sanctioned luge races.

## FIL INTERNATIONAL JUDGES LICENSE

You must hold the National Officials Certification as well as meet other specific requirements which encompass working various officiating positions during races. There is both a written and oral test that must be passed to become certified. The national federation conducts the course with an approved proctor from the FIL, and the FIL issues the International Judge License and Badge. The names of FIL judges are entered in the FIL Directory of International Officials with name and National Federation.

## REFRESHER COURSES

These are one day courses to refresh officials on the rules and procedures, and are offered every year at all the track locations. There is no fee to take a refresher. However, there is a \$10 fee for the refresher, if you are not current with your dues as a U.S. Luge Association member. This course covers any new rule changes, hands on and examples of situations that might arise with discussion on how they can be handled, and an opportunity to address any concerns or problems experienced during the season. Once you are certified as an official, you maintain \*"active" status by working a minimum of one race a season and attending a Refresher Course at a minimum of every two years. Volunteers are always welcome. It's a good way to get experience and see if it's something you really want to do before taking the National Course.

## AUDIT/ASSIST NATIONAL COURSE

This is for officials who are interested in becoming an instructor or assistant to teach future National Courses. Approved officials should be FIL3 level, but may be any FIL level. Certification will also require you to act as an assistant instructor at least once, then act as an instructor under the supervision of a "proctor" at least once.

The Lake Placid FIL & National Course & the Refresher will be held at the Lake Placid Olympic Training Center. For those of you that are coming from out of town, we are offering housing & meals (\$45 night – dormitory style) at the OTC with check-in beginning Friday afternoon and the latest check-out on Sunday. For those of you who are local and wish to join the group for meals (\$12), we can arrange that as well.

All FIL & National courses will begin on Friday night at 6:00 pm. They will run all day Saturday (approx. 9:00 am - 6:00 pm). Depending on size of class, we may finish testing on Sunday. Specific info for each course will be sent out.

All of the Refresher Courses are free of charge to U.S. Luge Association members. Refresher courses are generally held on the Saturday. The refresher is for already certified National and FIL officials. For the 2019-2020 season, if you have not taken a refresher course within the last two years (status "17" or earlier), you must attend a refresher to keep your \*"active" status.

You must be current on your membership dues to participate in any of the courses. Dues are \$50. If you are unsure of your status, please contact Beverly at the luge office. Please note: If you are an "active official", but are sliding as a "Masters" you are still an "O".
