Anti-Doping Policy and Requirements

USA Pentathlon MultiSport Anti-Doping Requirements

USA Pentathlon Inc., (dba, USA Pentathlon Multisport (USAPM)). All Athletes agree to be familiar with and bound by the Rules and Regulations of USA Pentathlon Multisport, including but not limited to the Competitive Rules adopted by USAPM, the anti-doping rules and procedures adopted by the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) and World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

It is the duty of all Athletes to comply with all anti-doping rules of WADA, the UIPM, the USOPC, and USADA and all other policies and rules adopted by WADA, the UIPM and USADA. If it is determined that an Athlete, Athlete Support Personnel, or other Person may have committed a doping violation, the individual agrees to submit to the results management authority and processes of USADA, including arbitration under the USADA Protocol, or to the results management authority of USAPM, if applicable or referred by USADA. In addition, Athletes agree to submit to drug testing by the UIPM and/or USADA or their designees at any time and understand that the use of methods or substances prohibited by the applicable anti-doping rules make them subject to penalties including, but not limited to, disqualification and suspension.
