### World Para Athletics Junior Championships Nottwil 2019 – Communication 1

Dear NPC President/Secretary General,

World Para Athletics are pleased to announce that the second edition of the World Para Athletics Junior Championships will take place once again in Nottwil, Switzerland in 2019.

The Championships will be held from 01 - 04 August 2019 and will take place at the Swiss Paraplegic Centre in Nottwil. The competition takes place over four days, from 01 - 04 August 2019, and kicks off with a special opening ceremony on 1 August, which is the Swiss National Holiday.

Classification will take place from 29 July - 31 July for athletes entering the competition with a Sport Class Status New (N) or Review (R).

## World Para Athletics Junior Championships Nottwil 2019

---

World Para Athletics Junior Championships Nottwil 2019 dates:

Arrival	28 - 30 July
Classification	29 - 31 July
Training	29 - 31 July
Competition	01 - 04 August
Departure	05 August

### Athlete Eligibility

---

To be eligible for entry, an athlete must:

- hold an active World Para Athletics Licence for the 2019 season;
- be aged between 14 and 19 years old on 31 December 2019 (age categories specified below);

#### Guide-runners

- Guide-runners must hold an active World Para Athletics License for the 2019 season.

### Age Categories

---

Athletes will be divided into two age categories at the World Para Athletics Junior Championships as follows:

- Under 20 (U20) Men and Women: Any Athlete born in 2000, 2001 or 2002
- Under 17 (U17) Boys and Girls: Any athlete born in 2003, 2004 or 2005

## Maximum Entry per NPC

---

- An NPC may enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per individual medal event. There will be no minimum entry standards.

## Event Viability Criteria

---

- A minimum of four (4) athlete entries from two (2) NPCs is necessary to sustain an individual medal event on the programme.
- World Para Athletics shall review the event viability following the close of the final entry by name on 20 June 2019. World Para Athletics also reserve the right to either cancel such events or run them as non-medal events.

## Timeline

---

28 February 2019	Preliminary entry by number.
03 June 2019	World Para Athletics open the online entry system for final entry by number and name.
13 June 2019	Deadline for NPCs to confirm the size of team delegation via the online entry system.
20 June 2019	Deadline for World Para Athletics to receive final Entry by Name from NPCs via the online entry system.

## Competition & Training Venue

Competition and training venue: Sport Arena Nottwil



The Sport Arena Nottwil is an official sanctioned sports facility for international competition such as the 'ParAthletics' World Para Athletics Grand Prix. It has 8 lanes mondo.

The training venue can be used from 29 to 31 July 2019, the precise times will be announced at an early stage. Medical and equipment repair services will be on site during these times. No fixed reservations can be made. We ask for mutual respect.

### **World Para Athletics Junior Championships Nottwil 2019 Competition Fee**

---

The competition fee for the World Para Athletics Junior Championships will be offered at a reduced rate of three hundred and twenty euros (320€) per delegation member for this Championships. A delegation member is defined as any accredited athlete, athlete competition partner, or team official who stays in official Championships accommodation and/or uses official Championships services. The total delegation entry fee is payable to World Para Athletics and will be calculated at submission of final entry and a final invoice will be generated based on this number. The competition fee includes all Championships services not limited to: ground transport from the official port of entry to the official Championships Hotels, ground transport between the official Championships venues, lunch and dinner.
