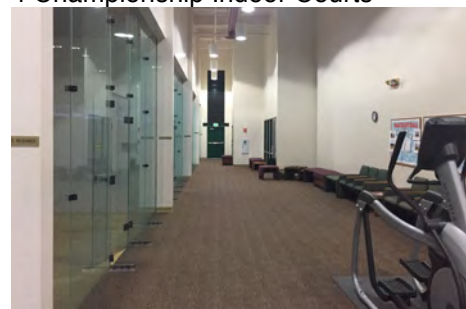

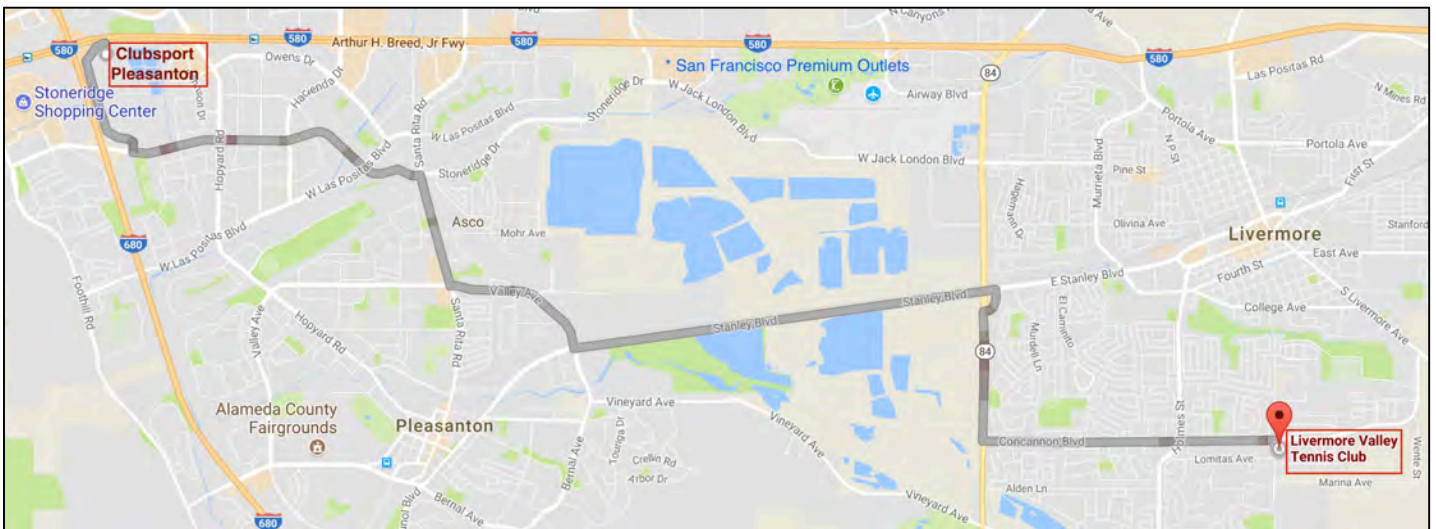


AIRPORT to CLUB/HOTEL: (23+ miles)
