## USA ROLLER SPORTS APPLICATION FOR ELITE COACHING STATUS

### CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

Items 1-5 are mandatory for consideration:

1. Applicant must have achieved Advanced (Level 3) coaching status.
2. Applicant must have completed the USARS mandatory background check.
3. Applicant must have competitive success as a coach as evidenced by coaching a minimum of 15 years and having at least 20 national placements by a number of different athletes.
4. Applicant must have demonstrated technical expertise in the sport.
5. Applicant must write a short paper on "Why I should be an Elite coach."
6. Applicant has created other successful coaches.
7. Applicant has contributed to the profession through official NGB programs and publications, given seminars, served on national committees, etc.
8. Applicant has had such an impact on the people they come in contact with that a permanent interest in roller sports is created (i.e. having former students still in skating in some capacity).
9. Applicant has exhibited fair and sportsmanlike deportment.
10. Applicant has a willingness to be a continuing resource for the federation.
11. Applicant has been a skating judge, has had some judging experience or has helped train judges panels.
12. Applicant has taught more than one discipline of skating (i.e. figures and singles, singles and pairs, dance and free skating, figure and speed).
13. Applicant has been a role model in their words and deeds for roller sports and has knowledge of roller sports history.
14. Applicant needs to have two reputable USARS Elite Coach Members, outside of the rink where the applicant is currently working, to sign off on the application prior to submission.
