KEY POINTS

- ▶ Bronze, Silver and Classic Silver skill levels shall skate TWO (2) requirements (dances or figures) for each round of competition. Gold and Classic Gold skill levels shall skate THREE (3) requirements.
- ▶ All dances are to be skated TWO (2) skaters/teams per flight.
- ▶ Classic Gold skill level will skate 2 minute flights. All other levels will skate FOUR (4) repetitions of the dance. Flights with ONE (1) skater/team are to skate FOUR (4) repetitions of the dance.
- ▶ Skaters **MUST** skate their age division (teams skate the appropriate age division of the younger partner).
- ▶ Skaters may **ONLY** skate one skill level (of their choice) within their mandated age division **AND** either the Classic Silver **OR** Classic Gold division.

KEY POINTS (CONTINUED)

- ▶ Any Adult Division skater who is an Elite, Advanced, Certified, or Registered Coach who wishes to receive coaching credentials for the National Championships in a given year, **MUST** choose to skate GOLD skill level for that skating season.
- ▶ Any Adult Division skater who has **EVER** been an Elite, Advanced, Certified, or Registered coach may **NOT** skate the BRONZE skill level in their age division.
- ▶ Any skater 18 and over may skate the Original Silver Compulsory Dance event OR Original Gold Compulsory Dance event.
- ▶ Any skater 18 and over may skate the Classic Events. Skaters can skate only one Classic skill level (Silver OR Gold) in any given discipline.
- ▶ All Classic events and Original Dance will be skated as final only.
- ▶ Classic Silver Dance will skate to orchestra music.
- ▶ Classic Gold Dance will skate one (1) requirement to orchestra music and (2) requirements to organ music.

What's Next

- ▶ At each Regional Coaches' Meeting, your Region Representative will lead discussion around the new structure.
- ▶ Any suggestions from the field will go to the Regional Representatives who will discuss the feedback and bring to the Figure Sport Committee any suggestions they feel should be considered in the new structure.
- ▶ All Division Requirements need to be chosen by the Regional Representatives and submitted to the Figure Sport Committee for final approval.
- ▶ The Rule Book will need to be revised to add the new structure and remove all rules pertaining to the old structure.
- ▶ The final proposal will go to the USARS Executive Committee for implementation in the 2017-2018 Skating Season.
