POOL SPECS: The complex features two outstanding indoor pools. See Appendix P for diagram.

Competition pool area

- 25 meters x 25 yards, depth ranging from 13 feet to 9 feet, as shown on diagram
- A lane line will be placed at the 25-meter mark. The remainder of the shallow end will be closed during the competition.
- At start end, the deck is 6" (24cm) above a 20" (51cm) wide gutter that is at water level. Competitors may dive from the deck, or step down to the gutter before entering.

Practice pool – available for warmups/ warm downs at all times

- Four 25-yard lanes
- Depth up to 4 feet
- Warmer temperature

POOL RENTAL: Lane rentals for US Synchro will be offered on the following days and times:

Saturday, July 7 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. (lanes are limited)

Sunday, July 8 1:00-5:00 p.m. (lanes are limited)

Tuesday, July 10 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. (first come, first served)

Lane rentals are available at the rate of \$12.50 per hour/per lane and may be reserved in one-hour increments or more with music in the competition pool. If a qualifying event is held after the entry deadline for this competition, a provisional entry must be submitted according to the above deadline. Within 72 hours of the completion of the qualifying competition, the proof of qualification must be submitted by phone and in writing to the meet manager.

Meet qualification will be entered in online registration, showing qualifying meet, year, and qualifying score.

Entry is not complete unless accompanied by payment, including foreign federations.

FEE INFORMATION

- **Entry Fee** \$25 per competitor per routine, including reserves (alternates). Make check payable to USA Synchro. Any swimmer who is listed as a reserve (alternate) for a routine and who is not swimming any other routine event shall pay the entry fee. (Rulebook, Appendix C) Foreign Federations do **NOT** pay this fee.
- **Sponsor Fee** \$25 per competitor. Make check payable to USA Synchro.
- **Credentials** Each club will receive coach and chaperone credentials per the chart below. Chaperone credentials do not allow deck access. Additional credentials can be purchased for \$30 each. Make checks payable to USA Synchro.

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EVENTS

1. In the Junior Open, US clubs may only enter three solos, three duets and three trios. Multiple entries in the Junior Team event are allowed.
2. Juniors and Seniors may compete in the free combination as a separate event. Competitors who are 13 and 14 years of age may participate in the free combination event. A club or national team may enter an unlimited number of combination routines. An individual competitor may be entered in only one combination routine.
3. Foreign federations may have multiple club entries, including their national teams, in each category: Junior, Senior and Free Combination (open category).
4. The total number of competitors per foreign club or national team may not exceed 12.
5. In the Junior Open, each foreign club or national team may enter three solos, three duets, one trio and/or one team. Note that only one solo or duet from each foreign club or national team shall advance to finals.
6. In the Senior Open, each foreign club or national team may enter two solos, two duets and/or one team.
7. An individual competitor may only enter three events. They may in addition enter only one Free Combination event.
8. Junior athletes may not swim in the same event in both Junior and Senior categories of competition.
9. Senior entries must enter **both** technical and free competition. All Senior routines advance from tech prelims to free finals, with tech prelim results used for the draw.
10. Qualifying scores do not apply to foreign federations.
11. The top 12 in each event will move to finals. The 13th place routine in each event will serve as the pre-swimmer for the event.

OFFICIALS

Please register online by the entry deadline. In addition, please email Judges Administrator Linda Loehndorf your intent to attend (loehndorf@charter.net). The dress for all events will be white tops and white bottoms.

FINA and UANA judges will be seated with U.S. judges on the event panels. A FINA Evaluator will attend the US Open.

NOTE: Federations entering may submit up to two officials from the FINA and/or UANA List(s) of synchronized swimming officials for the U.S. Junior Open and the U.S. Senior Open Championships. FINA and/or UANA judges from federations not entered in the competition may attend to practice judge.

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COACHES All U.S. coaches on deck must be 100 percent certified by USA Synchro. Please check that you are certified on the USASynchro.org website under Education and the Coaching Certification Program. If there are any concerns, please contact Kevin in the national office, and bring any proof of certifications not shown on the website to registration.

SCORING We expect to use three score scoring for free routines, and 2/4 scores for technical routines.

AWARDS All competitors (U.S. and foreign) will compete for the same awards. Medals will be awarded for places 1-3, and ribbons for places 4-12. In the Senior category, medals and ribbons will be given to reserves (alternates) who swim either the technical or free routine. In the Junior category, medals and ribbons shall be given to competitors who swim in finals only.

PHOTO/VIDEO REGULATIONS

Personal use photography will be allowed. No flash photography.

Any photographs, videotape or other audio and/or visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use, and may not be broadcast, published or disseminated, or used for any commercial purposes, without the prior written consent of U.S. Synchronized Swimming.

VENUE RULES

For final events, tickets or credentials are required for admittance to the venue.

No smoking in the facility.

No glass containers on the deck or in locker rooms.

Use of the pool equipment is not permitted.

All athletes will abide by the facility rules and USA Synchro Athlete Code of Conduct.

Gelling and de-gelling in designated areas only (\$100 fine if outside of designated areas).

All equipment bags must remain in designated areas to maintain a clean deck.

Official team banners will be hung by meet management (please turn in at registration)

Handmade signs cannot be posted.

Coolers are permitted on the deck in designated area

No electrical appliances are permitted.

FOOD SERVICES A concession stand will be open during competition times.

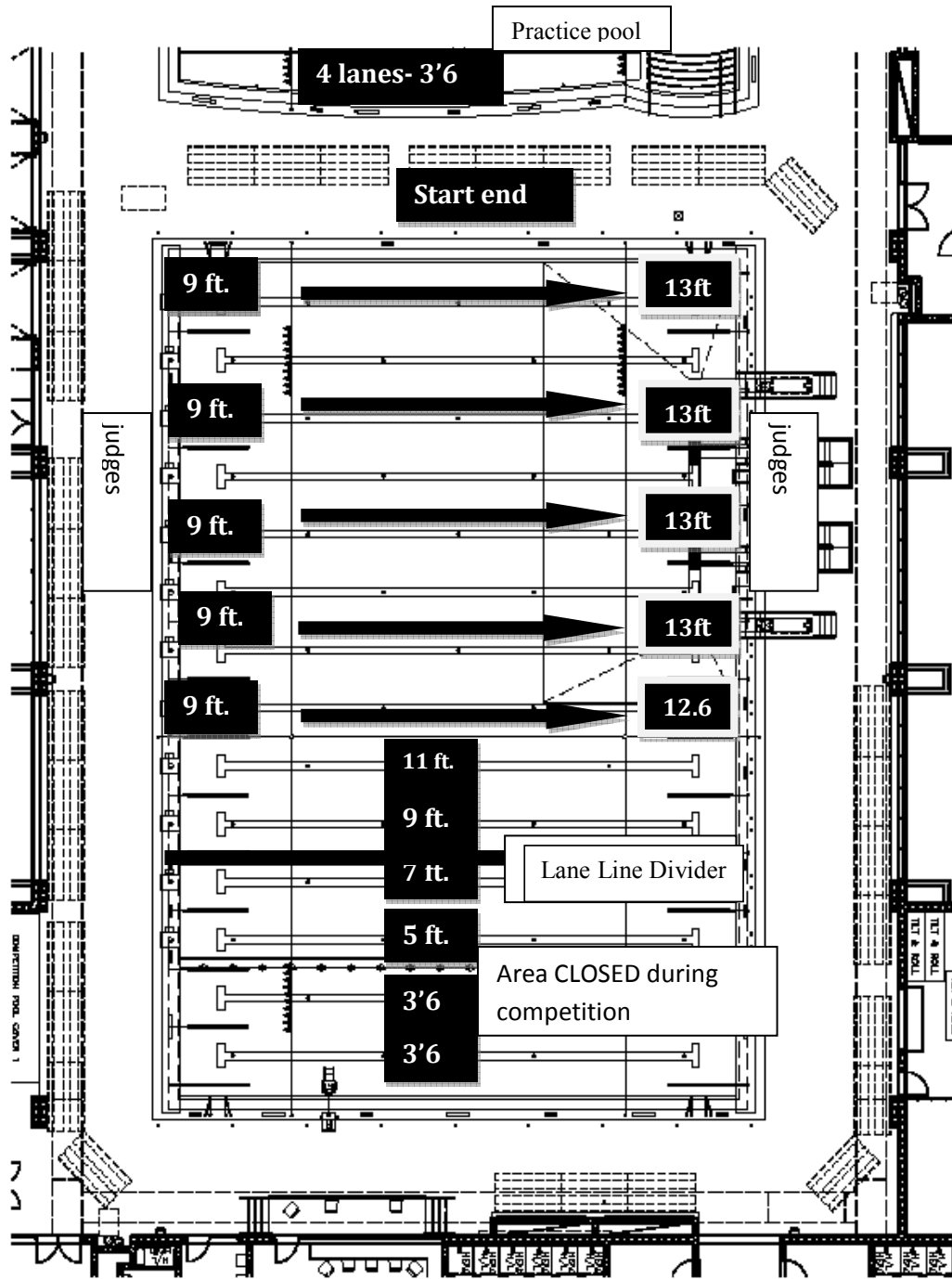
