Competition Pool Area
 - 25 meters x 25 yards, depth ranging from 13 feet to 9 feet, as shown on diagram.
 - A lane line will be placed at the 25 meter mark. The remainder of the shallow end will be closed during the competition.
 - At start end, the deck is 6" (24cm) above a 20" (51cm) wide gutter that is at water level. Competitors may dive from the deck, or step down to the gutter before entering.
- RULES TO GOVERN** The 2014 Official USA Synchro Rulebook shall govern the championships under FINA rules with the exceptions listed.
- ENTRIES** U.S. teams may register online only. If a qualifying event is held after the entry deadline for this competition, a provisional entry must be submitted according to the above deadline. Within 72 hours of the completion of the qualifying competition, the proof of qualification must be submitted by phone and in writing to the meet manager. Meet qualification will be entered in online registration, showing qualifying meet, year, and qualifying score.

COACHES All U.S. coaches on deck must be Level 2 certified by USA Synchro. Please check that you are certified on the USA Synchro.org website under Education and the Coaching Certification Program. If there are any concerns, please contact the National Office, and bring any proof of certifications not shown on the website to registration. Coaches are reminded that they need to carry their USA Synchro proof of certification to be allowed on pool deck.

OFFICIALS U.S. officials must register online at USA Synchro.org for Officials Availability. Contact Pam Edwards with any questions at pamsync@sbcglobal.net. Official’s testing will be held on Wednesday, July 16th during team practice with music. Testing location to be determined. The dress for all events will be white tops and white bottoms.
FINA and UANA judges will be seated with U.S. judges on the event panels.
A FINA Evaluator will attend the US Open.
NOTE: Foreign Federations entering may submit up to two officials from the FINA and/or UANA List(s) of synchronized swimming officials for the U.S. Junior Open and the U.S. Senior Open Championships. FINA and/or UANA judges from Foreign Federations not entered in the competition may attend to practice judge.

- FEE INFORMATION**
- Entry Fee \$30 per competitor per routine, including reserves (alternates). Payments are made online at the USA Synchro.org website. Any swimmer who is listed as a reserve (alternate) for a routine and who is not swimming any other routine event shall pay the entry fee. (Rulebook, Appendix C) Foreign Federations do **NOT** pay this fee.
 - Sponsor Fee \$25 per competitor. Payments are made online at the USA Synchro.org website. Foreign Federations must send a check for the required sponsor fees to Jennifer Hawkins at USA Synchro.
 - Credentials Each club will receive coach and chaperone credentials per the chart below. Chaperone credentials do not allow deck access. Additional credentials can be purchased for \$30 each. Payments are made online at the USA Synchro.org website.

AWARDS All competitors (U.S. and Foreign) will compete for the same awards. Medals will be awarded for places 1 - 3, and ribbons for places 4 - 12. In the Senior category, medals and ribbons will be given to reserves (alternates) who swim either the technical or free routine. In the Junior category, medals and ribbons shall be given to competitors who swim in finals only.

EVENTS

1. In the Junior Open, U.S. clubs may only enter three solos, three duets and three trios. Multiple entries in the Junior team event are allowed.
2. Juniors and Seniors may compete in the free combination as a separate event. Competitors who are 13 and 14 years of age may participate in the free combination event. A Foreign club or national team may enter an unlimited number of free combination routines. An individual competitor may be entered in only one free combination routine.
3. Foreign Federations may have multiple club entries, including their national teams, in each category: Junior, Senior and Free Combination (open category).
4. The total number of competitors per Foreign club or national team may not exceed 12.
5. In the Junior Open, each Foreign club or national team may enter three solos, three duets, one trio and/ or one team. Note that only one solo or duet from each Foreign club or national team shall advance to finals.
6. In the Senior Open, each Foreign club or national team may enter two solos, two duets and/ or one team.
7. An individual competitor may only enter three events. They may in addition enter only one free combination event.
8. Junior athletes may not swim in the same event in both Junior and Senior categories of competition.
9. Senior entries must enter **both** technical and free competition. All Senior routines advance from the technical preliminary events to free finals, with the technical preliminary results used for the draw.
10. Qualifying scores do not apply to Foreign Federations.
11. The top 12 in each event will move to finals. The 13th place routine in each event will serve as the pre-swimmer for the event.

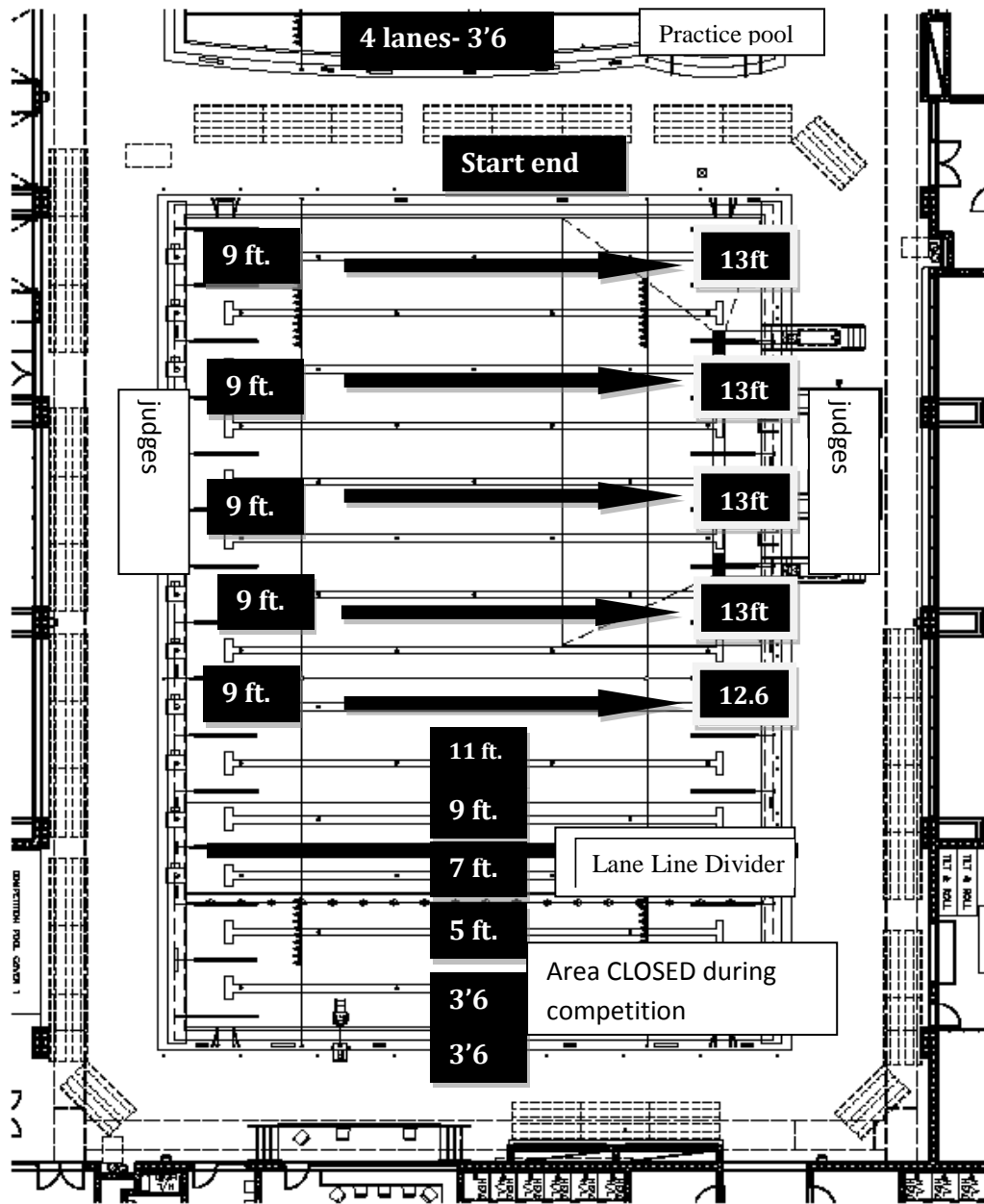

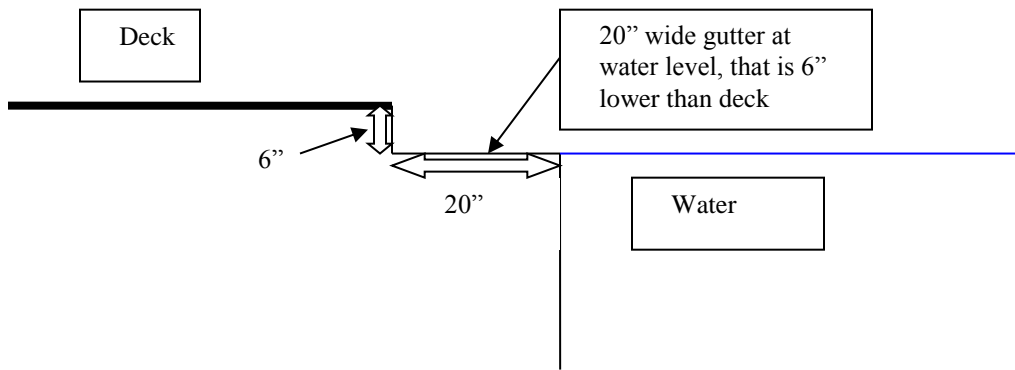
