



Code of Ethics

USA Table Tennis requires its volunteers and staff to conduct business with integrity, to maintain a standard of ethical conduct consistent with the laws and regulations of the United States, and other countries and jurisdictions in which the USATT conducts business.

Accordingly, volunteers and staff are required to comply with the following:

- Conduct all dealings with honesty and fairness.
- Respect the rights of all employees to fair treatment and equal opportunity, free from discrimination or harassment of any type.
- Know, understand and comply with the laws, regulations, and code of conduct governing the conduct of USATT business - both domestic and foreign.
- Ensure that all transactions are handled honestly and recorded accurately.
- Protect information that belongs to the USATT, our donors, sponsors, suppliers and fellow workers.
- Avoid conflicts of interest, both real and perceived.
- Never use USATT assets or information for personal gain.
- Recognize that even the appearance of misconduct or impropriety can be very damaging to the reputation of the USATT and act accordingly.
