

2015 World Cadet Program – qualification process

- *Canadian Junior Open* 1 day prior (NA event) 25%

The day prior to the Canadian Junior Open an North American Cadet qualifying tournament will be hosted. The affiliated association may enter a maximum of 12 boys and 12 girls in this event.

The results will be translated into a point scheme worth 25% of the overall points scale.

- *US Open / Canadian Junior open*(participation mandatory)

Players who try out for the ITTF NA Cadet team must compete in the US Open and in the Canadian Open Cadet event.

- *NA Cadet Championships* 40%

The results of the ITTF NA Cadet Championships will be translated into a points scheme worth 40% of the overall points scale. The affiliated association may enter a maximum of 12 boys and 12 girls in this event.

- ITTF World Ranking – ITTF NA players only (September Ranking) 35%

• The selected team must participate fully in all preparation activities, e.g., cadet team training camp; failure to participate will result in loss of the spot on the team. On rare occasions, the ITTF NA BOD may grant an exemption if a player is engaged in another ITTF competition during the time of the preparation camp.
