We have come to agreements with two local hotels near the Ohio State campus. Please see below for a breakdown of the two hotels and the agreements we have with each of them. You are welcome to choose any hotel that you wish, but for the price and the accommodations, these are two of the better options on a high and low end.

1. Marriott and Residence Inn – Columbus University Area

 - i. Room rate is for two queen beds (players) or a single queen bed (coaches).

 - iv. 9 person shuttle which runs within a 3 mile radius at all times. Scheduling shuttle in advance secures chance to use it at certain times.

d. Nightly rate: \$75/room.

i. Room rates are for two queen beds (players) or for one queen bed (coaches).
