

USA Volleyball Social and Digital Media Guidelines for Participation in USA Volleyball High Performance Training Programs

USA Volleyball ("USAV") encourages participants to share their experiences with their friends, family and supporters via social and digital media. These guidelines (the "Guidelines") are designed to ensure that these activities respect USA Volleyball values and the rights of others. Postings made by, or on behalf of, Participants must comply with these Guidelines and conform to applicable laws.

These Guidelines apply to all persons participating in a USAV High Performance Training Program, including all athletes, coaches, officials, and staff ("Participants"). They apply from the time of registration for the USAV High Performance Training Program to the last Participant's departure from the USAV High Performance Training Program.

Permissible Use:

Participants may capture and use still photographs, video and audio ("Content") at USAV High Performance Training Programs provided:

- Such Content is used for non-commercial and non-promotional use
- Such Content can only be shared on the Participant's personal social and digital media accounts (alternative postings may be approved by USAV in writing)
- Such Content must not be made available on social, printed publications and digital media accounts owned by, or promoting any commercial organization, without USA Volleyball's prior written approval.

Non-Permissible Use:

Any social or digital media postings may not be made for the purposes of demonstration or any form of political, religious or racial propaganda. They must be dignified and not be discriminatory, offensive, hateful or defamatory.

In particular, when using social and digital media, Participants must not:

1. intrude upon the privacy of others;
2. infringe any intellectual property rights, or other rights of the International Olympic Committee, United States Olympic Committee, USA Volleyball or any other person or organization;
3. disclose any confidential information or another person's or organization's private information;
4. interfere with the events; or,
5. violate security measures for the safe conduct of the events.

Penalties:

When a Participant is found to be in violation of these Guidelines, USAV may require the concerned Participant to remove any infringing content, or, depending on the circumstances, may take further measures up to and including immediate dismissal of the Participant from the USA Volleyball High Performance Training Program, taking legal action, or imposing any other penalties as appropriate under the circumstances.

Acknowledgment:

I understand that if I fail to abide by the Guidelines, I may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from the USA Volleyball High Performance Training Program.
