CLINIC REQUIREMENTS

All participating drivers must:

- ✓ be at least 18 years of age and a current *Active* member of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports
- ✓ pay a \$10 clinic fee to USA Water Ski & Wake Sports (**not required for clinic instructors**)
- ✓ have a current Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) Review certification on file with USA Water Ski & Wake Sports
- ✓ comply with and meet all requirements for boater's training and/or licensing under state law applicable in the driver's state of residence

Class A Driver Learner's Permit Testing: Participant must have taken the online course and successfully passed the written test and Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) Screening prior to the clinic and show proof thereof to be eligible to take the on-water practical evaluation.

- ✓ providing all required evaluation materials for each participating driver
- ✓ forwarding the completed clinic registration form, clinic fees and evaluations to USA Water Ski Headquarters

NSSA TESTED DRIVER CLINIC RESPONSIBILITIES OF HOST CLUB

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- **General:**
 - ✓ locating and securing a qualified NSSA Driver's Clinic Instructor
 - ✓ providing a location for both the classroom and on-water portions of the clinic
 - ✓ downloading the *NSSA Tested Driver Student Manual* and *NSSA Rulebook* from USA Water Ski & Wake Sports Web site and providing a printed or electronic copy for each participating driver
 - ✓ verifying that **ALL** clinic participants (including drivers, skiers and other personnel) are current *Active* members of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports
 - ✓ collecting all fees and forwarding to the Clinic Instructor

- **Eligibility:**
 - ✓ verifying that drivers meet eligibility requirements at least one week prior to the scheduled clinic date.
NOTE: Individual drivers may verify their current driver's rating and Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) Review certification status by logging into their Members-Only section of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports Web site under *Official Ratings & Certifications/My Official Rating*. Clubs may also verify their drivers' current rating and MVR Review certification status by logging into the Club's Members-Only section and using the *Club's Officials Roster*.

- **Equipment:**
 - ✓ TV/DVD or computer for classroom portion of the clinic
 - ✓ Ski jump that is in the water
 - ✓ Starting dock large enough to accommodate a minimum of 12 skiers
 - ✓ Adequate number of skis for jump, doubles and strap doubles
 - ✓ Pickup boat and appropriate personnel available
 - ✓ Radios for boat-to-boat and boat-to-shore communications

- **Skiers:**
 - ✓ Class A Driver Evaluations – 10 Skiers (minimum 5 males and 5 females)
 - ✓ Class B Driver Evaluations – 14 Skiers (minimum 7 males and 7 females)
 - ✓ Class C Driver Evaluations – 18 Skiers (minimum 9 males and 9 females)

- **Recommended Skier Skill Requirements:**
 - Males**
 - ✓ All male skiers must be able to perform a hop dock start
 - ✓ All male skiers must be able to perform a shoulder dock start and carry a 3-high pyramid
 - ✓ One to two male skier(s) for a strap doubles couple (must have familiarity and prior skiing experience with partner)

 - Females**
 - ✓ All female skiers must be able to perform a braced ballet hop dock start
 - ✓ All female skiers must be able to climb to a second tier pyramid position and four of the five women must be able to hold a third tier individual
 - ✓ One to three female skier(s) able to climb to a third tier pyramid position
 - ✓ One to two female skier(s) for a strap doubles couple (must have familiarity and prior skiing experience with partner)

 - Other**
 - ✓ One jumper to perform a two-ski ride over
 - ✓ Any mix of skiers who can do the above will also be acceptable
