

USA Weightlifting National Team Guide to Coronavirus Scenario Planning for 2021

A final qualification event is scheduled as an in-person event and moves online due to Coronavirus.

The online event will count for qualification for the same events that the original event would be due to have counted for. (Note, American Records will not be permitted). See specific events for how and when USA Weightlifting will make decisions on in-person events.

A competition was due to take place in 2020 and has now been moved to 2021 (EXCEPT the Pan American Championships 2020 and Olympic Games).

The team originally named will be re-invited using the ranking list after the final qualification event.

**Subject to age eligibility confirmation from the IWF or PAWF.

A competition is due to occur in 2021, a team has been named, and the competition is delayed within the calendar year 2021.

The team originally named will be re-invited using the ranking list after the final qualification event.

A new competition is scheduled during the year 2021.

We refer to the existing 2020-2024 selection process and calendar policy. In the event that it is not possible to have an in-person competition, or a replacement online competition, a selection camp will be held 5 days before the RTP deadline (60 or 90 days as applicable), using the Top 20 for the age group concerned using 6 months worth of local and online meets, including international online meets.

A competition has a final qualification event inside the 60 or 90 day RTP rule, but there has been no necessary qualification events.

All online events, international online events (where the result is formally published by the sanctioning body), local events and online national events will be used to determine the Top 20 to be submitted to the IWF by the deadline. In the event such an event then gets postponed outside of the 90 day window from the final qualification event, all athletes become eligible.
