**Matter: Anonymous vs Member Sean Waxman  
Summary Decision: Dismissed as of 6/12/2018.**

Dear Parties,

A complaint was filed with the USA Weightlifting Ethics Committee, a committee made up per the USA Weightlifting bylaws of four independent and uninterested individuals and one Elite Athlete Representative, regarding the treatment of a member by a fellow USA Weightlifting member.

The committee discussed the facts of the complaint as described by Anonymous at their June 25, 2018 Meeting.

The complaint alleges that a safety squat bar funded by USA Weightlifting intended for the use of Elite Athlete, Caitlin Hogan, was retained by Waxman's Gym and is being used for other athletes.

The Committee received statements from the USA Weightlifting staff to the effect that while funding had been approved for such a bar, no bar had actually been purchased yet by USA Weightlifting.

The Ethics Committee hereby dismisses the complaint against Sean Waxman with no action.

An appeal to this decision may be made to the USA Weightlifting Judicial Committee via the USA Weightlifting National Office.
