MILWAUKEE, WI – US Speedskating will hold the U.S. Long Track Fall World Cup Qualifier/AmCup 1 on Oct. 31-Nov. 4, at the Pettit National Ice Center (500 S 84th Street) to select the Fall World Cup Team that will compete in these four international events:

World Cup #1 – Obihiro, JPN	Nov. 16-18, 2018
World Cup #2 – Tomakomai, JPN	Nov. 23-25, 2018
World Cup #3 – Tomaszow Mazowiecki, POL	Dec. 7-9, 2018
World Cup #4 – Heerenveen, NED	Dec. 14-16, 2018

The ladies' competition will feature two-time Olympian **Brittany Bowe** (High Point, N.C.), joined by her fellow 2018 Olympians **Carlijn Schoutens** (Heemstede, Netherlands), **Erin Jackson** (Ocala, Fla.) and **Jerica Tandiman** (Kearns, Utah).

Men competing in the event will include two-time Olympian **Joey Mantia** (Ocala, Fla.) and 2018 Olympian **Kimani Griffin** (Winston-Salem, N.C.).
