The Trevian AWD Fall Classifier will be a classification meet for athletes with disabilities. This meet will also be open to any athletes with disabilities who would like to receive official U.S. Paralympics Classification.

Appointments for athletes with a physical impairment will be scheduled for all athletes requesting U.S. Paralympics Classification between Noon and 7:00pm on Friday, September 6th at New Trier's Northfield Campus.

The swim meet will take place on Saturday, September 7th at 10:00 at New Trier's Winnetka Campus. ***Note that national classification and swim meet will take place at two different locations.***

Entries are unlimited and athletes do not need to be attached to a high school team.

- If a swimmer has not been previously classified, he/she should enter at his/her estimated classification, and adjustments may be made as necessary following the classification evaluation preceding the competition.
