In order to be eligible to receive this scholarship your final application must be completed by June 11, 2018.

If you are awarded the scholarship, and decide to attend the Acton School of Business:

- First semester is completed part-time, online, July 30th – December 17th (2018), and can be done from anywhere in the world. During this first semester, most students continue working in their current jobs, and complete their Acton work (20-30 hours per week) at night and on the weekend.
- Second semester, January 7th – May 18th (2019), takes place on Acton's campus, in Austin, TX. The second semester involves 80-100 hours per week, and requires a full-time commitment.

A few notes about applying for this scholarship:

- The GMAT is not required, as we do not believe it is the best judge of who will be successful at Acton, or in life as an entrepreneur. We have our own diagnostic, which is part of the application process.
- An undergraduate degree is not required to apply, as we have learned that many of the qualities that make a great entrepreneur are not related to having a traditional education. However, anyone who graduates Acton without an undergraduate degree will not receive the formal MBA credential.
- If you are awarded the scholarship, you will be notified three weeks after submitting your application, and be required to give your acceptance decision within two weeks of receiving your acceptance letter.
