NATIONAL SKILLS TESTING RULES

- During all phases athletes must wear white cap and black swimsuit. There may not be any club affiliation displayed on the athlete's swimsuits or caps.
- For routines, the draw numbers may be written on the caps and/or the athletes' bodies.

- 4 Panels of Judges will be judging figures during the 2023 U.S. 13-15 Championships. 5 FINA Judges, PAQ Judges, FINA Evaluators and/or National Judges will be judging routines in Phase 3 B. 1 NT Coach will be judging Synchronization during the Individual Swims.
- Scoring by judges will be calculated according to FINA rules. The ISS scoring software will be used for Phase 3 A Figures.

SUMMARY OF SKILLS TESTING

Phase 1A: 4 Figures chosen by the HPM & NT Coaches posted 72 hours prior to the start of National Team Trials. All athletes from Phase 1A shall advance to Phase 1B.

Phase 1B: 2 Land tests & Swimming Sequence.

Up to a maximum of 50 athletes, in rank order, shall advance to Phase 2A.

Phase 2A: 2 Figures chosen by the HPM & NT Coaches and posted 72 hours prior to the start of National Team Trials. All athletes from Phase 2A shall advance to Phase 2B and 2C.

Phase 2B: 2 Land tests

Phase 2C: Artistic Swimming Routine – 1 Individual Swim

Up to a maximum of 30 athletes, in rank order, shall advance to Phase 3.

Phase 3A: 4 Figures posted 72 hours prior to the start of 13-15 National Championships.

Phase 3B: 1 Individual Swim & 1 Group Swim.

LATE FEES

Athletes: registration received between 27 and 7 days prior to the first day of the competition shall be assessed a \$25.00 event entry late fee and \$10.00 per routine entry late fee. No entries shall be accepted between 7 and 0 days prior to the first day of competition.

Coaches, Chaperones, Team Manager and Others: registration received between 27 and 14 days prior to the first day of competition will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee per individual.

Certifications for Coaches, Chaperones, Team Managers and Others: certifications submitted between 27 and 14 days prior to the first day of competition will be assessed at \$25.00 late fee per certification. This includes Background, SafeSport, CCP and First Aid/CPR. No certifications will be accepted 14 or less days prior to the meet and no refunds will be processed.

COACHES CERTIFICATION AND SAFESPORT

CCP Level 1 - Required for all coaches to be on deck at any land or water training or sanctioned competition.

CCP Levels 1 & 2 - Required for all coaches to be on deck at any Regional or Zone Championship, unless the coach was certified at CCP Level 1 less than one year prior to the relevant National Championship.

CCP Levels 1, 2 & 3 - Required for all coaches to be on deck at any National Championship, unless the coach was certified at CCP Level 1 less than one year prior to the relevant National Championship.

Background Screening - Required for all coaches & chaperones on deck at any sanctioned competition. See Appendix Q for full list.

SafeSport - Required for all coaches, chaperones and team managers to be on deck at any sanction competition. (This includes chaperones, trainers, and any other team personnel).

CPR/First Aid - Required for all coaches to be on deck at any sanctioned competition.

Professional Membership required for coaches & athlete safety membership required for team staff & chaperones.
