Details for Sunday's Road Race

Participant Checkpoint

All athletes are required to enter the venue through the COVID-19 checkpoint at Columbia High School. **This includes athletes who are riding their bikes to the venue.**

- You must enter the high school off of Farrow Road
- You must go through the COVID Checkpoint
- You must bring and present your credentials

Venue Requirements

Once athletes are cleared in to the athlete parking area, athletes are restricted from interacting with individuals who are not in the Tier 1 group of event staff. Please do not exit the field of play or the athlete parking area.

- Do not interact with VIPs or event spectators
- Athletes are not permitted in the VIP area
- **Athletes cannot travel up the sidewalk to the VIP area as this is prohibited by our COVID-19 protocols for the event.** Instead, go up the far side of the course on Explorer Boulevard.
- You may interact with the media, ONLY if an interview is arranged with the event press officer, who will contact you with some further direction.

Awards Ceremonies

Masks are required on the podium. Please remember to bring your mask to the podium.

All athletes finishing in the top 3 positions of their classification must attend awards ceremonies. [Please refer to the competition schedule](#) as there are three (3) awards ceremony sessions on Sunday. **All classifications who compete in the session preceding the scheduled awards ceremony will be awarded.**

Access to the Podium and Race Viewing (for athletes ONLY)

Athletes attending podium ceremonies, or athletes who would like to view the finish line, MUST take the following path to the athlete podium/viewing area during the following times:

- 11:50am
- 1:50pm
- 4:20pm

The athlete podium and viewing area is on the median of Explorer Boulevard. To access the area:

- Cross Explorer Boulevard at the entrance to the high school and walk / wheel up the Explorer Boulevard on the far side of the Median to the podium / viewing area.
- Please only cross Explorer during the pre-designated times listed above.
